Greetings and Happy New Year (Happy Valentines Day) from Liberty Well Community Council! You are probably wondering what is the current status of the Liberty Wells Decorative Street Lighting Project. Here is where we are in the Community Block Development Grant Process: The signatures from various streets were collected summer 2003, there was such a great response we decided to divide the project into six different grant applications, the applications were named according to the original subdivision names for the areas, we gathered letters of support from community organization within our boundaries, the grant applications were submitted on time, the applications went through the Citizens Review Committee, Mayor Ross "Rocky" Anderson's Office Review and finally the Salt Lake City Council Review. The final outcome was an award of \$60,000 for design and engineering for the entire Liberty Well Community Council Area (900 S. to 2100 South and State Street to 700 East). This year we resubmitted all six of the applications from last year and an additional application for \$190,000 to complete funding for the design and engineering of the entire area (total \$250,000). We kept the original signatures that were collected and updated our letters of support. We also had another group, The West Liberty Neighborhood Watch that submitted an identical application for the area called Jackson Square (Harvard to Edith Avenue and State Street to 500 East). This area will get twice the consideration! This year's applications are just coming out of the Citizens Review Committee and will be going to the Mayors Office and City Council during these next two months.


