

SEARCHING FOR A SCHOLARSHIP

FIRST STEP

When searching for scholarships, start with the Office of Financial Aid & Scholarships at the University of Utah: <http://www.sa.utah.edu/finance> (Click “Scholarships”). Fill out a FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Financial Aid) on their website and talk to a Scholarship Counselor at the Financial Aid Office (105 SSB, 581-6211).

UNIVERSITY RESOURCES

There are a number of scholarship applications available for new freshmen, transfers, and students continuing at the University of Utah at www.ugs.utah.edu. Highlight “New or Current Student” and then click “Scholarships from Student Initiatives”.

Another great place to look is on the Office of Diversity web site: <http://diversity.utah.edu/> (Click “Scholarships”). Two excellent scholarships are the Larry & Gail Miller Enrichment Scholarships (new and continuing students) and the Utah Opportunity Scholarships (new students only).

Also visit your major advisor to discuss possible departmental scholarships and the Kennecott Scholarship.
