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Letters of reference are to include documentation, including examples, which may be provided in any or all of the following:

TEACHING

- helped student apply theory to practice
- individualized learning objectives to meet students needs and goals
- encouraged study, question and research
- was available to student as needed
- facilitated exposure to other disciplines, if possible
- exposed student to a variety of treatment modalities
- helped student gain wide range of experiences

KNOWLEDGE

- possessed information regarding therapeutic or organizational dynamics, theories, typologies, etc.
- demonstrated commitment or learning by professional readings and seminars.

SKILLS

- demonstrated techniques, approaches, modalities
- provided opportunity to apply knowledge to practice
- exposed student to various styles in intervention

ATTITUDES

- supervisor served as a professional model
- contributed to the field of social work through writing, serving on committees, professional organization, research, development of standards and guidelines, grant development, legislative activities, delivering of papers at academic and/or professional conferences.
