- If necessary, a student may take SW 4301 OR SW 4401, or an elective course, or a certificate/minor/second major course during Practicum term. *No more than one approved* course may be taken during Practicum term.
- SW 4702 and SW 4782 comprise practicum requirements and are to be taken in final program term.
- SW 3400 is required for all students who start the BSW program beginning with the Fall 2019 cohort.
