### **Courses:**

- Courses are held on Fridays from 5 PM to 9 PM and Saturdays from 9 AM to 5 PM.
- Practicum (fieldwork) is completed on other weekdays in your general geographic area. The
  majority of practicum placements are during normal business hours. Evening/weekend
  opportunities are likely to be limited.

# **Grades:**

- MSW students must earn a C+ or better in each of the required courses, including Practicum, to take the second course in any sequenced courses (e.g., Practice I and Practice II) and to move forward in the program.
- MSW students must maintain a cumulative 3.0 GPA in order to be in good academic standing.

## **Area of Focus:**

- Students in the Three-Year Program will take courses in the Mental Health area of focus.
- Students must take one Advanced Practice course outside of chosen area of focus in year two.
- School Social Work is not an area of focus. School SW courses count as electives, and only students admitted to the School Social Work career path may take these courses.

#### **Reminders:**

- Students in the Three-Year Program must successfully complete a minimum of 60 credit hours to graduate.
- Only courses offered within the Three-Year Program may be taken.
  - o **Salt Lake City cohort:** Register only for courses with section number 630, 631, etc.
  - o **St. George cohort:** Register only for courses with section number 635, 636, etc.
  - o Registration permission codes will be sent to you ahead of each semester.
