

# INTERN WITH JUVENILE JUSTICE SERVICES (JJS)

Interning with us may introduce you to a number of programs making a positive influence in the lives of young people.

## Locked Detention

### **WHAT IS IT?**

Locked detention provides short-term confinement for delinquent youth awaiting adjudication, placement, or serving a sentence ordered by a Utah Juvenile Court Judge.

### **WHAT HAPPENS THERE?**

Youth participate in school, cognitive behavioral skill building groups and recreational activities. Family involvement including visitation is available and strongly encouraged.

## Youth Services

### **WHAT IS IT?**

Youth Services provides crisis intervention, short-term day treatment and after-school individualized services for youth so they can safely remain in their homes, schools and communities.

### **WHAT HAPPENS THERE?**

Implement research-based approaches to prevent delinquency, improve positive youth development and keep the community safe. Each youth is screened for behavioral or mental health concerns and families are connected to community resources.

## Case Management

### **WHAT IS IT?**

The Case Manager acts as a liaison between the youth, Juvenile Court, Youth Parole Authority, parents, and JJS programs.

### **WHAT HAPPENS THERE?**

Case Management services include monitoring and supervising youth, and developing and implementing treatment plans.

## Secure Care

### **WHAT IS IT?**

Secure Care is long-term locked facility for youth who are ordered into JJS custody.

### **WHAT HAPPENS THERE?**

To help promote success, youth are provided with mental health, educational, recreational and medical services. They also have the ability to participate in other classes and programs to enhance their individual talents.
